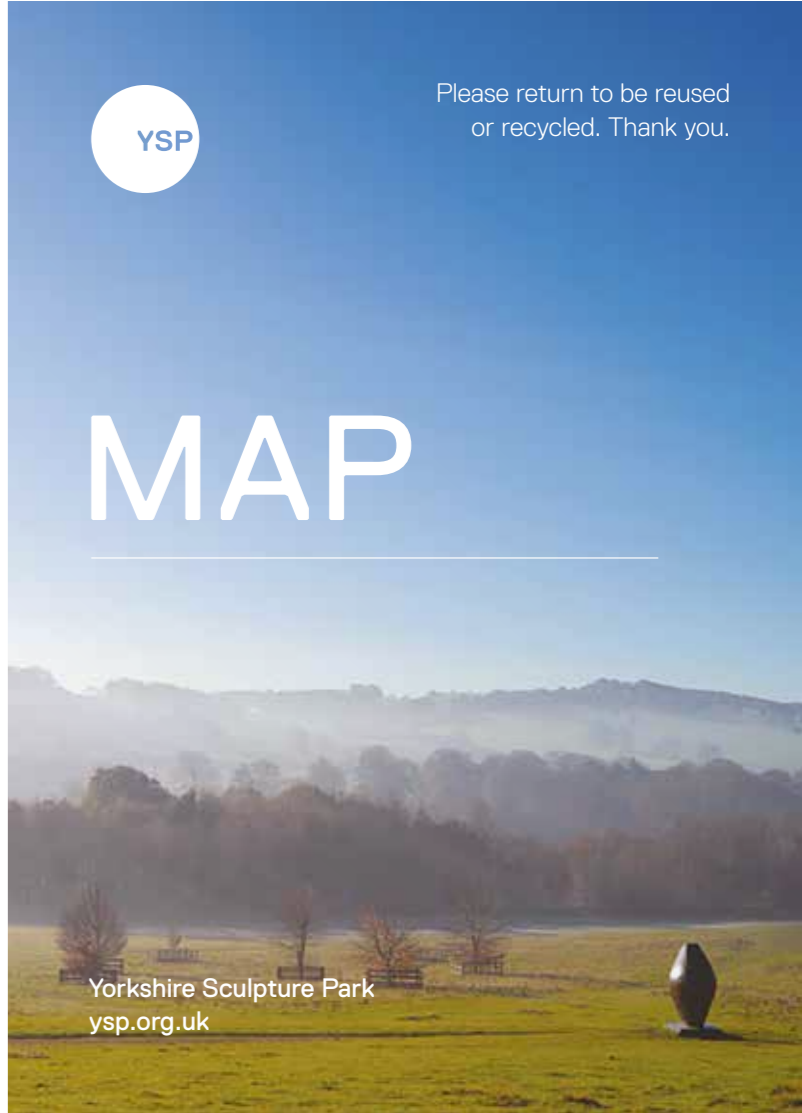

Yorkshire Sculpture Park is located in the 500-acre Breton Estate. If you have a full day (or two!), you'll have time to explore the whole park and all the sculptures within it, along with various galleries displaying temporary exhibitions.

Our outdoor collection comprises long and short-term loans, site-specific commissions and gifts from individuals and artists.

At YSP Centre, explore the latest exhibition in the Upper Space, enjoy a meal in The Kitchen Café with views across the valley, or a light bite at The Coffee Shop. Follow this with a browse in the YSP Shop, featuring a unique selection of products from international artists, contemporary designers and makers.

Next to YSP Centre, you'll find major temporary exhibitions in the large Underground Gallery. There's also the historic Formal Garden and Terrace where you can enjoy stunning views across the landscape. Across the park, The Weston includes The Weston Gallery, Restaurant, Rock Garden and Terrace and The Weston Shop.

To the west, YSP Learning incorporates The Café, Garden and Haylort Studios, and Hidden Forest, where often at weekends and during the holidays, you'll find drop-in or pre-booked events for all the family. See yp.org.uk/events for details.

In the middle of the park, the Lower and Upper Lakes and surrounding woodland provide tranquil walks. Discover bridges, follies and incredible historical features including a Greek-style summer house, a now land-locked Boat House, an Obelisk and a magical Shell Grotto. A circular walk around the lakes takes approximately two hours.

After you've explored the Underground Gallery and enjoy views of the **Lakes** from **Cascade Bridge**. Return to **YSP Centre** via the **Country Park** to see our collection of bronzes by Henry Moore.

Head to **Little Wild Wood**, located in front of **YSP Centre**. Create, discover and imagine as you play amongst the trees.

If you have half a day...

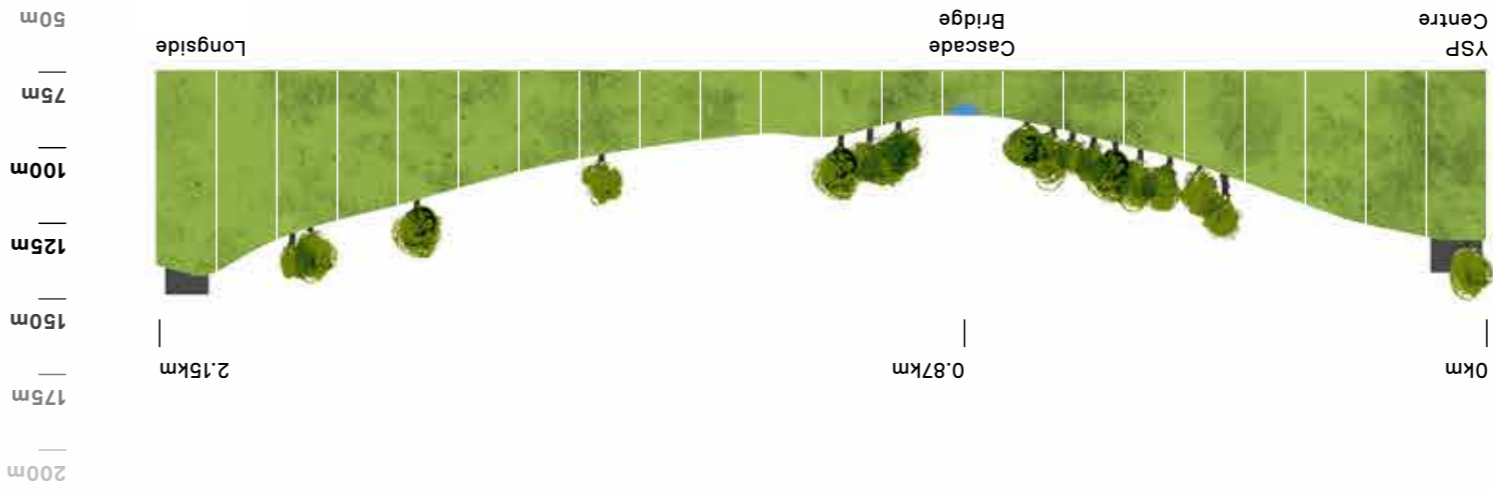
After exploring **Lower Park** and the views from **Cascade Bridge**, take a walk up the hill to **Longside**. Carry on back to **YSP Centre** passing works of art by Sean Henry, Andy Goldsworthy and David Nash as you go.

If you have a couple of hours...

See what's on in the **The Weston Gallery** before taking a walk through the **Country Park** calling at the **Chapel**. Don't miss James Turrell's *Deer Shelter Skyspace*, an exceptional space for contemplation, as you walk up the hill to **YSP Centre**.

If you have half a day...

Take a 5km round walk through the woods and up the hill to Longside. See land art by Andy Goldsworthy and David Nash as you go before returning to **The Weston** along the shore of **Lower Lake**.

Please follow the YSP Code – you can help us keep YSP beautiful
