## A day at YSP

Yorkshire Sculpture Park is located in the 500-acre Bretton Estate. If you have a full day (or two!), you'll have time to explore the whole park and all the sculptures within it, along with various galleries displaying temporary exhibitions.

Our open-air collection comprises long and short-term loans, site-specific commissions and gifts from individuals and artists.

At YSP Centre, explore the latest exhibition in the Upper Space, enjoy a meal in The Kitchen with views across the valley, or a light bite at Centre Coffee. Follow this with a browse in Centre Shop, housing a distinctive selection of products from international artists, contemporary designers and makers.

Next to YSP Centre, the large Underground Gallery and smaller Bothy and Garden Galleries have changing exhibitions throughout the year. There's also the historic Formal Garden & Terrace where you can enjoy stunning views across the landscape.

Across the park, The Weston includes The Weston Gallery, Restaurant, Rock Garden & Terrace and The Weston Shop. Go south to discover Longside Gallery, home to the Arts Council Collection Centre for Sculpture (during exhibitions only).

To the west, YSP Learning incorporates The Café, Garden and Hayloft Studios, and Hidden Forest, where often at weekends and during the holidays, you'll find drop-in or pre-booked events for all the family. See [ysp.org.uk/events](http://ysp.org.uk/events) for details.


In the middle of the park, the Lower and Upper Lakes and surrounding woodland provide tranquil walks. Discover bridges, follies and incredible historical features including a Greek-style summer house, a now land-locked Boat House, an Obelisk, Stepping Stones and a magical Shell Grotto. A circular walk around the lakes takes approximately two hours.

## Explore from three starting points

### YSP Centre

Approximate walking times / distances from the YSP Centre to:

**The Weston** about 18 minutes / 1.2km  
**YSP Learning** about 8 minutes / 588m  
**Longside Gallery** (via Oxley Bank) about 39 minutes / 2.5km

#### If you have a couple of hours...

Check out the latest **Underground Gallery** exhibition before walking around the **Bothy Garden** to enjoy views across the park. Wander over to **Hillside** to see Barbara Hepworth's *The Family of Man*, recently restored after more than 30 years on display.

#### If you have half a day...

After you've explored the Underground Gallery and works on Hillside, walk down to **Lower Park** and enjoy views of the **Lakes** from **Cascade Bridge**. Return to **YSP Centre** via the **Country Park** to see our collection of bronzes by Henry Moore.



### YSP Learning

Approximate walking times / distances from YSP Learning to:

**YSP Centre** about 8 minutes / 588m  
**The Weston** about 25 minutes / 1.7km  
**Longside Gallery** (via Cascade Bridge) about 39 minutes / 2km

#### If you have a couple of hours...

Explore **Hillside** and **Lower Park** where you'll find works by Barbara Hepworth, Sophie Ryder and Anthony Caro, then take a walk around **Upper Lake** looking out for historic follies along the way.

#### If you have half a day...

After exploring Lower Park and the views from Cascade Bridge, take a walk up the hill to **Longside**. Visit the Longside Gallery (open during exhibitions), or carry on back to **YSP Centre** passing site-specific works of land art by Andy Goldsworthy and David Nash as you go.



### The Weston

Approximate walking times / distances from The Weston to:

**YSP Centre** about 18 minutes / 1.2km  
**YSP Learning** about 25 minutes / 1.7km  
**Longside Gallery** (via Oxley Bank) about 39 minutes / 2.5km

#### If you have a couple of hours...

See what's on in the **The Weston Gallery** before taking a walk through the **Country Park** calling at the **Chapel** to see Ai Weiwei's *Iron Tree*. Don't miss James Turrell's *Deer Shelter Skyspace*, an exceptional space for contemplation, as you walk up the hill to **YSP Centre**.

#### If you have half a day...

Take a 5km round walk through the woods and up the hill to **Longside**. See land art by Andy Goldsworthy and David Nash as you go, and pop into the Longside Gallery (open during exhibitions). Find refreshment at Longside Kiosk (open during exhibitions) before returning to **The Weston** along the shore of **Lower Lake**.


